



## CCC Church Jerusalem Trip FAQ

1. What would be the additional cost to travel business class?
  - a. There are 2 upgrade levels, but pricing will not be available until approximately eleven months prior to travel date. Here's a rough estimate:  
**Premium Economy - \$2000 - \$4000 above current's trip cost**  
**Business Class - \$4000 - \$6000 above current's trip cost**

2. When can we register and when are payments due?
  - a. Registration is open online today!
    - We recommend monthly payments:
      - Initial deposit of \$400, per person
      - Monthly payments of \$335 each month starting in August
      - This will pay your \$6026 paid in full by due date of December 1, 2026

***You are not required to make monthly payments. However, you are required to meet the minimum payment amounts below.***

- **\$1,400 paid per person must be received by April 1, 2026**
- **\$2,400 paid per person by August 1, 2026**

*(Payments of any amount can be made at any time as long as the milestone amounts above are reached per person.)*

3. Do we need a passport or is the Real ID sufficient?
  - a. **MUST** have a passport that is **valid for 6 months after until October 31, 2027**
    - If you don't have one, we recommend you apply by 8 months in advance
  - b. Travelers **\*\*MUST\*\*** obtain an [ETA-IL \(Electronic Travel Authorization\)](#) before departure. *(We recommend you apply for this by the date of your final payment. Cost is approximately \$7.00).*
4. Do we need to get any immunizations before the trip?
  - a. No, HALLELUJAH!

5. Will people with mobility issues be able to come on the tour?

Israel is not ADA compliant. We always drive as close to the sites as possible. Having said this, to really experience Israel, we do a considerable amount of walking, and the terrain is uneven most places. Of course, anyone may choose to opt out of any sites they wish and stay either on the bus or the guide will find a good location to wait.

6. What meals are included?

All Breakfasts and Dinners at wonderful buffets at your hotel. Lunches will not be included, but will be around \$10 per day at various local stops while touring.
